


Corrective Action Plan (CAP) Oak Cliff Grades

The PEIMS department is leading the transition from eSchool to Aeries software. This project started on October 1st, 2021 and will continue throughout this school year. Click <u>here</u> to see the milestones and plan for the project. Project updates for the month of March 2022 are below:

- Master Schedule File was completed on January 20, 2021
- ✓ Aeries Academy training for Corporate, Principals, Assistant Principals, Counselors, Registrars and Data Clerks on May 9, 10 and 24 2022.
- ✓ The Compliance Unit started reviewing some students in the application.
- ✓ PEIMS is considering the Integration between Tableau and Aeries. Cognos capability is not cost efficient connecting with Aeries.
- All Special Populations Codes are mapped.
- Master Schedule will be created in eSchool and transfer to Aeries during the integration.
- Historical Data start to be transferred.
- ✓ Third party export data will start on May 4, 2022.

Process Description

One of the goals of the compliance unit is to analyze the systems established to ensure compliance with TEA policies, plans, procedures, laws, and regulations that could have a significant impact on operations and reports and in determining the district's compliance status.

Compliance is ensuring that all the policies, procedures and processes are house in one location that is available for the entire organization: DocCentral.

Compliance updates the material on DocCentral periodically at the request of district leaders.

Registrar Centralization - Calibration

The Compliance Unit in conjunction with PEIMS, Registrars and Administrators completed the proposal for centralizing and calibrating the processes and procedures for this important operational position. 
From the Grading Issue at Oak Cliff campus the testing department received 9 Credit by Exam Requests. The details of the timelines are described below:



Students Placed in Appropriate Classes

To fulfill with this condition the following items are under detail review by the compliance unit:

1. Data Roster inside of SMS: During the 360 this area was reviewed and the following campuses were not in compliance: Dallas North. Due to staff shortage Pleasant Grove, Austin and CFB were not evaluated in this area.

- 2. TREx: The TREx report that is inside of the enrollment metrics demonstrate that only 6 students were missing TREx and Transcripts.
- 3. Duplicate Credits: The Duplicate Credit report above demonstrate the district success in this condition. The Data Entry team is collaborating with the Counseling Unit to proactively prevent future duplicates.
- 4. Blanks on EOC Scores: The Data Entry team during the month of March 2022, review every single blank score in the student's transcripts. The team found 2,543 records missing scores and a report was provided to Counseling Department for a second review to ensure students are placed in appropriate classes.
